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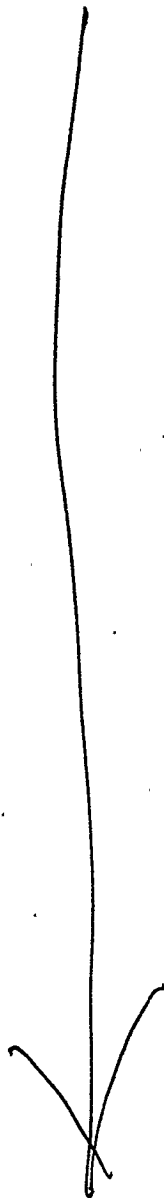

AT A MEETING WITH HSCA OFFICIALS ON AUGUST 16, 1977, CHIEF COUNSEL ROBERT G. SUCH AGREEMENT WOULD FOLLOW PRECEDENT OF THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE WHICH IN ITS REPORT DURING 1976 DID NOT LIST THE NAMES OF ANY FBI PERSONNEL BELOW THE POSITION OF SECTION CHIEF.
