Subj: Interagency Support between NAVSEA and the Central Intelligence Agency

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 7030.2 of 2 September 73; Subj: Interagency support between the Navy and the Central Intelligence Agency  
(b) OPNAVINST 7030.3 of 6 December 73; Subj: Control procedures for interagency support between the Navy and the Central Intelligence Agency; Implementation of

1. Purpose. To implement references (a) and (b) and assign responsibility for interagency support between the Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) and the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

2. Definition. For purposes of this instruction, "support" means the expenditure of resources including personnel, money and materials to aid the CIA in its mission. Examples include the loan of personnel, resources expended to develop information such as comparative costs for ship construction or weapons development, etc. It does not apply to furnishing readily available and releasable information such as copies of technical manuals or the exchange of oral/visual information during the course of approved visits.

3. Discussion. References (a) and (b) assign responsibility for support between the Navy and the CIA to the Director of Naval Intelligence (OP 009) and establish the following procedures:

a. CIA requests for Navy support will be submitted for approval to CNO (OP 009MX) via the Joint Chiefs of Staff, (JCS).

b. Navy requests for CIA support will be submitted to CNO (OP 009MX) for approval and execution of letters of agreement, as appropriate.

c. CNO (OP 009MX) will coordinate with the Secretary of the Navy for approvals and letters of agreement and will ensure that all billings or other transfer of funds between the Navy and CIA are processed through the Assistant to the Comptroller of the Navy for Special Programs.

d. CIA will refer all proposed visits to Navy commands and contractor facilities and requests for Navy information to CNO (OP 009MX) for coordination.


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4. Action

a. Addressees will obtain clearance from the NAVSEA Comptroller (SEA 01) in advance of any proposed participation in informal or formal interagency support agreements with the CIA. SEA 01 will obtain approval of CNO (OP 009MX), if required.

b. The Accounting Procedures and Operations Division, (SEA 018) will process funding documents received from the CIA or proposing to apply NAVSEA funds to CIA support.

c. The Security Division, (SEA 09G2) will coordinate with cognizant and interested Directorates all CIA requests for technical information and proposed visits by CIA personnel including employees of the National Photographic Interpretation Center (NPIC) to NAVSEA shore activities and contractor facilities (when access to NAVSEA information is involved), and will establish such disclosure/access limitations as may be appropriate.
