Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NAVAL TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT (NISC-10)

1. Purpose. To announce the establishment of the Naval Technology Department.
2. Effective Date. Immediately
3. Background. Naval technology related functions are currently performed by elements scattered organizationally as well as geographically. For example, current NISC technology assessment functions are performed in NISC-36, NISC-512, and NISC-OOWT. Technology transfer operations are centered at Chesapeake Beach, with supporting elements resident at Suitland. Contractual support efforts relating to foreign use of advanced naval technologies are currently being monitored and controlled in separate organizational elements. There are potential benefits to bring these efforts under centralized management.
4. Organization. Enclosure (1) depicts the tentative organization of the Naval Technology Department (NISC-10). The mission of this department is to provide intelligence on foreign applications of science and technology to naval uses, to assess foreign capabilities and limitations in incorporating advanced technology into naval systems, to assess foreign availability and transfer of technology of naval interest, and to manage and execute the Navy Foreign Materiel Program.
5. Action. The Technical Director will act as Chairman of an ad hoc group consisting of Dr. William Reese, CAPT T. Fritz, CDR E. McCulloch, CDR M. Jewell, Mr. G. Shepherd, and other NISC support when designated. This group will complete by 30 April 1985 the administrative actions required to establish this new department.
6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice is cancelled upon completion of the administrative set up of the department, the incorporation of the organization details, missions, and functions into the NORM, and for record purposes 30 April 1986.
